

Week 3: Household

DIY Pipe Cleaner



What you need:

- 1/2 cup baking soda
- 1/2 cup of vinegar
- a damp cloth
- 1 liter of boiling water

Let's go:

1. Pour the baking soda from the cup into the drain pipe to be cleaned.
2. Pour the vinegar slowly.
3. Cover the drainpipe with the damp cloth.
4. Leave the baking soda/vinegar mixture to soak in for about 10 minutes.
5. Pour 1 liter of boiling water.

ATTENTION: The pipe cleaner can splash, therefore never hold your face directly over the drain pipe!
